The company has recently installed a further two BES Bollman Kilns which has taken the number of on-site kilns to four, including three high capacity and highly efficient BES Bollman Kilns, increasing the company's pallet drying capacity to the highest in the UK. We now have the capacity to heat treat and/or dry all newly manufactured or repaired pallets, and can heat treat/kiln dry customers' pallets, packaging and timber.

4-way entry
