- To identify process and equipment improvement opportunities (maintenance schedules and equipment capability / reliability.)
- To complete all maintenance activities on time as planned.
- To be flexible in attendance to complete activities.
- To follow instructions provided by site management / supervisors.
- To maintain a clean and tidy work area at all times.
- To be a proactive team member.
- Improve technical skills and knowledge at all times.
